A down-filled navy blazer? "That wasn't easy at all to make. Moncler's never done this level of tailoring, and for me, I had to compensate for how the down affects the fit of a jacket. It took a few trips to Milan, but they have amazing people and we eventually got it."

Favorite pieces? "I have a down vest in a suiting fabric and one of the technical ones. I wear them

over suits or sport coats or to the gym."

How durable are we talking? "Some of the pieces are coated and water-repellent. Some are just much warmer than my stuff. So if you're on the slopes in those, you'd better not fall."

The future? "I'm working on the fall 2010 collection right now. I'm contracted for four more seasons."
