# IN THE COUNTRY

## On the Trail of Summer

The Swahili word *safari* translates as "journey," and August is the right time to embark on one—whether it's along a local bird-watching trail or across the Serengeti Plain. Here (clockwise from right) are some of the goods to wear and take. The Lady N Boot from HUNTER (\$140; hunter-boot.com) works for both riding and walking. A SIGG reusable aluminum water bottle (\$21.99; mysigg.com) and a pair of OAKLEY Breathless sunglasses (\$155; oakley.com) fit easily into SANDSTORM KENYA's Shikari bag (\$450; sandstormkenya.com), which is hand made in Nairobi by Kenyan tribal artisans. The BERLUTI artist's sketching satchel is made of deerskin (\$2,000; berluti.com). FILSON's first line of women's clothing includes a nylon-taffeta quilted vest (\$98; filson.com), beneath which you could wear BERETTA's nylon field jacket, which features linen-accented pockets and cuffs (\$1,125; beretta.com), and a silk bird-motif scarf (\$300; beretta.com).
